# **Exploratory audit in the Netherlands (1)**

#### **Focus**

The enforcement of the EU waste shipment legislation in the port of Rotterdam



## **Background**

- Export of dangerous waste to non-OECD countries is prohibited by EU Waste Shipment Legislation
- Notification procedures for enforcement
- EU member states are responsible for implementation and enforcement



# **Exploratory audit in the Netherlands (2)**

### Results

- In general no significant shortcomings
- Points of attention for international context of the enforcement:



- Implementation of the enforcement differs among countries
- No uniform definition of 'waste'
- International enforcement fragmented

### Follow up

Explore possibilities for an international coordinated effort



# NCA Proposal for coordinated effort

#### **Ambition**

- Participating SAIs describe enforcement (organization and execution) *European audit*
- 2. Insight in cooperation between countries regarding the enforcement of waste streams possibility for global audit

### **Current phase**

- Exploratory contact with other SAIs through EU CC and EUROSAI-WGEA, no decision taken yet
- Norway, Bulgaria, Hungary and Thueringen (Germany) are interested
