Continues to link its logic to the strategic goals of INTOSAI


- Goal 1: up-date existing and develop new guidance materials and conduct research studies on emerging topics in environmental auditing field

- Goal 4: increase cooperation between the WGEA, international organizations and other INTOSAI bodies


New feature - research project
