"Mother Theresa" International Airport is close to Tirana (around 17 km from the city center) and the Tirana International Hotel is well accessible from the Airport.

The price for the taxi service from the airport to the hotel is about 20-euro one way.

### Weather

October is one of the best months to travel to Tirana. It offers pleasant weather with mainly sunny days and occasional rain. Daytime temperatures varies between 22° C and 27° C, while the night temperature varies between 11°C and 15°C.

#### Dress code

## Currency

The currency used in Albania is Albanian LEK (ALL) which is pegged to the Euro at the exchange rate of 1 Euro= 133,8 Lek. Cash payments are generally accepted in ALL but some shopping Centers, restaurants and other services accept Euro and take credit cards.

Other convertible currencies can be exchanged for ALL at all the banks and exchange offices in the city and at the airport. You can withdraw from the ATM s, services available for 24 hours
